My EMT and Paramedic Savings

Start saving early! The earlier you start, the easier it is to make it to your goal of going to EMT school.

Grade Level	Monthly Savings
8th	EMT School = \$1700 approximately \$425 per year = \$35 per month savings
10th	EMT School = \$1700 approximately \$556 per year = \$47 per month savings
11th	EMT School = \$1700 approximately \$850 per year = \$70 per month savings
12th	EMT School = \$1700 approximately \$1700 per year = \$142 per month savings

Save for EMT, Paramedic school or other career training options. Open a membership savings account with a low minimum balance. The Credit Union will ask for your student status.

- Discuss the best option with your parents.
- Save a portion of your income each month.
- Consider a loan for school.
- Build your credit history by using your savings as collateral for your loan, (once you will have your full savings balance available to you once the loan is paid).
- Think about how you can best prepare for the cost of a career training program.
